## *What can I expect?*

### What I bring

I bring my baby bean bag and baby woven basket (for babies single shots), bunch of neutral rompers, bows and sheer curtains (to hang if you don't have any). I know it sounds weird that I bring my own curtains but to help to diffuse the natural light and helps to cover up whatever is outside the window! p.s. I do attach the curtains with pram clips to existing curtains or I use painters tape to the wall, I haven't had any issues yet (touch wood)!

### Where I like to shoot

Natural light is where it's at! I don't ever turn on overhead lights, and I normally hover around a big window! If we need to move things around the room I don't have any shame to do so!

### What about fur babies

YES! They are always welcome, I do recommend to wait til the end to include them as by the end of the session the animals are settled with me being in their environment.

### How can I prepare baby?

I do like to shoot in the morning as most kids are happier in the morning! Every baby is different, some babies are asleep during the session and some are watching me the whole time! My goal is to keep the baby settled, awake or asleep! I do recommend to keep to your normal schedule, and if your baby is awake and happy while I'm there great, if they fall asleep, amazing! However, I always encounter that babies need a break and a little feed during the session, so please don't be afraid to feed baby during the session, as I mentioned before, I just want your baby to be settled.
